

# **HORSES**

Dept. A – Pottawatomie County 4-H and FFA Junior Horse Show  
Superintendents: Laurie Snyder and Rene Underwood

- Rule 1. Entries shall open at 8:00 a.m., Thursday, Sept. 8, 2016. Entries close 2 classes prior.
- Rule 2. Horse Show shall start at 10a.m. Timed events shall not start before 4pm
- Rule 3. Contestants will be members of Pott. Co. FFA and/or 4-H as determined by those organizations.
- Rule 4. Each contestant may enter up to two horses.
- Rule 5. Horse shall be owned or leased by contestant, parent, sibling, grandparent or legal guardian.
- Rule 6. Age of contestant and horses shall be as of January 1, 2016.  
Exception: 9 yr old 4-H members may have been 8 yrs of age on Jan. 1
- Rule 7. A horse shall be shown by one contestant only.
- Rule 8. Contestants shall enter their age division only.
- Rule 9. Contestant or horse shall enter same class once only.
- Rule 10. Each contestant-horse combination shall be a separate entry.
- Rule 11. Contestant failing to show correct entry number in the arena shall not be placed.
- Rule 12. Negative Coggins Test Required. NO EXCEPTIONS.  
Horses entering the Pott. County 4-H and FFA Junior Horse Show must have a current negative Coggins Certificate dated within 12 months of the fair horse show date. Horses without a current negative Coggins Certificate will not be allowed to show and must leave the grounds immediately.
- Rule 13. No uncastrated male horses born prior to Jan. 1, 2015 shall be shown.
- Rule 14. No nursing foals or mares with unweaned foals shall be shown.
- Rule 15. Timed events-Closed gate start and finish shall be used.
- Rule 16. Hi- Point Buckle
- a. All classes with the exception of Halter Mares (Junior & Senior) Halter Geldings (Junior & Senior) and Grand-Reserve Halter shall count toward Hi-Point.
  - b. Points are accumulated on a one-horse-one rider basis and points accumulated on different horses are not combined.
  - c. Refer to Rules 5 & 6, page 6, Oklahoma State and District 4-H Horse Show Rule Book for point tabulation and tie-breaking procedures.
- Rule 17. 2016 Oklahoma State & District 4-H Horse Show Rules shall be used.
- a. Rule book may be purchased at county extension office.
  - b. Exception: Goat Tying Rules are adapted from IFYR Rules with closed gate entry.
- Rule 18. Judge's decision shall be final.
- Rule 19. The Awards Assembly will be at 7:00 p.m. Saturday. The Hi-Point Buckle, Buckles for Showmanship and Buckets for Grand Champion winners will be awarded at the assembly.
