#### American Farmers and Ranchers- Gilbert Insurance Agency Canning Awards:

All first-place entries for Fruit, Vegetables, Pickles and Soft Spreads (excluding dried fruits and vegetables) will be considered for Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion awards in each category. Grand Champion awards will receive a rosette ribbon and \$10 premium. Reserve Grand Champion awards will receive a rosette ribbon and \$5 premium.

- Rule 1. All exhibits will be in sealed regulation canning jars. Size of jar should be ½ pint, Pint or Quart.
- Rule 2. NO Colored jars will be accepted for judging. No ½ pint wide mouth jars accepted.
- Rule 3. Exhibitors under 18 years old as of the first day of the county fair must enter Junior Division unless there is not a place for entries, then one can enter Open Class.
- Rule 4. Jars should be transported with metal ring. Rings can be removed upon entry. Jars must be clean and rust free. Rusted rings or flats will not be accepted.
